remember our core

There is simply a lot going on around Crossroads these days! God is changing lives and we are actively pursuing what we understand to be His purpose for the Church...to be disciples who make disciples. To make disciples takes a relational environment. This means a context where two or more people are connecting in a meaningful relationship and an intentional process – a specific determination to help one another pursue loving others and living like Jesus. That's what we are about.

Some may feel overwhelmed by the various relational and intentional environments we have shared with you lately. Good stuff, but a lot of stuff. The upside is it means we have lots of opportunity. The downside is it can feel like there is so much you get a bit paralyzed and perhaps unsure as to what to engage in.

Don't forget The Core - Our desire is that each person who is part of Crossroads is engaged in three ways: 1) faithful attendance on Sunday mornings; 2) authentic connection in a small group environment; 3) active service in at least one way. We believe these three things are core to a disciple growing and making other disciples. Without each, there is something lacking that is needed to grow individually and corporately. This is expressed in our mission to love, connect and serve on the journey with Christ.

So, when you are personally tempted to feel overwhelmed by the opportunities, just remember the core: 1) faithful attendance on Sunday mornings; 2) authentic connection in a small group environment; 3) active service in at least one way. If you are engaged in these three ways, you are being intentional about your journey with Christ.

As a church family, let's remember the core and know that even though someone may not participate in one thing they may be connected in another. No one can or should participate in everything available. Let's pray for one another to have wisdom and discernment about when and how we engage. We each have a responsibility to prayerfully consider how God is leading us to participate in order to be encouraged and be an encouragement.
