As we reach the peak of summer, something for parents to remember is water safety. Except for congenital disorders, drowning is the number one cause of death in children ages 1-4. Here are some tips:

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission's Pool Safety campaign has been working to spread the word about drowning prevention. Its tips include:

- 1. Never leave a child unattended in or near water.
- 2. Teach children how to swim.
- 3. Teach children to stay away from drains.
- 4. Ensure all pools and spas both in your backyard and any public pool you may visit have compliant drain covers.
- 5. Install proper barriers, covers, and alarms on and around your pool and spa.
- 6. Know how to perform CPR on children and adults.
