
Ephesians 4:4-6 (ESV)

I. Paul's Call toWorthy Living – v. 1

I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called...

Apostle Paul – Eph. 4:1 ESV

I. Paul's Call to Worthy Living

Four Key Observations- v. 1

- 1. "I therefore..." Points back to the entire first part of Ephesians "In light of these truths, here's how to live..."
- 2. Paul points to his life & ministry as an example of worthy living -- "I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, I urge you..." Points back to 3:1, 13; also 2 Tim 1:8/Philemon 1:1,9

I. Paul's Call to Worthy Living

- 3. Note the passion of his appeal-
 - "I urge you to live/walk..." NIV/ESV
 - "I implore you to walk..." NASB
 - "I beg you to lead a life..." NLT
- 4. Key Command- Live Up to Your High Calling

"I urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called..." – v.1b

Three Key Components to This Command


- "walk"- how you live, your conduct, manner of life See also Ephesians 4:17; 5:2, 8, 15
- "worthy" suitable, appropriate to who you are See also Philippians 1:27 and Colossians 1:10
- "calling" our new, lofty status as God's children The way we live is to match our high calling in Christ!

II. What 'Worthy Living' Looks Like- vv. 2-3

 The rest of Paul's letter spells out how to live out our high calling as followers of Christ

Similar to Romans 12:3-8; Col. 3:12-15; Titus 2:7-8; 3:8

But Paul begins this section of his letter by noting
 5 characteristics of worthy living- vv. 2-3



II. Paul's Descriptionof Worthy Living –vv. 2-3

Five Characteristics of the Spiritually Blessed

Characteristic #1: Humility

- + "Be completely humble..." Ephesians 4:2 NIV
- + "Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment..." Romans 12:3
- + Word means "to think or judge with lowliness"
- + Reflects the character of Christ- Matthew 11:29 "Take my yoke...! am gentle & humble in heart"

Characteristic #2 : Gentleness/Meekness

"With all humility and gentleness" – Eph. 4:2

- "Therefore, as God's chosen people... clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience."-Colossians 3:12
- + Word was used in reference with training wild horses- means "power/strength under control" >> Strength under God's control

Characteristic #3: Patience

- "Be patient with each other" Ephesians 4:2 NLT
- "Therefore, as God's chosen people... clothe yourselves with...patience." Colossians 3:12
- + Literally "long-tempered" one who endures negative circumstances and never gives in to them- but trusts God's plan for their lives is for their good.


Characteristic #4: Forbearing Love/Endurance

- "...bearing with one another in love" Eph. 4:2
- "...love covers a multitude of sins."-1 Peter 4:8
- + Literally "to put up with one another in love"
- + Forbearing love takes abuse from others while continuing to love them with the love God supplies

Characteristic #5: Unifier/Peacemaker

- "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace" Eph. 4:3 NIV
- "Eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit..." (ESV)
- + Not a call for Church organizational unity -
- "keep/maintain"-not create (see 1 Cor 12:13)
- + Actively seeking to recognize and safeguard our spiritual unity in Christ (see Rom 12:18; 14:19)

Why does Paul see this as important?

The Unity of the Spiritually Blessed


- A. The Work of the Holy Spirit- v. 4
- "There is one body and one Spirit" Eph. 4:4
- + "one body"- Places us into the body of Christ
- + "one Spirit" The Holy Spirit we all share in as believers 1 Corinthians 12:13
- "For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and all were made to drink of one Spirit."

- B. The Work of the Son-the Lord Jesus- v. 4b-5,7
- "...you were called to one hope...—one Lord, one faith, one baptism..." Ephesians 4:4b-5
 - + "one body"- Universal body of Christ
 - + "one hope" Heaven; Christ's return, Eternity
 - + "one Lord" Christ is Lord of all-confession of Christ-followers for over 2,000 years.

- B. The Work of the Son-the Lord Jesus- v. 4b-5,7
- + "one faith" All are saved by faith in Christ All believers hold to one truth-Jude 1:3
- + "one baptism"- into Body of Christ-1 Cor. 12:13
- + "grace given to each one of us" spiritual gifts

- C. The Work of God the Father- v. 6
- "...one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all." Ephesians 4:6
- + "one God" One True God Deut. 6:4-5
- + "one Father of all" We share in the same spiritual Father—who is Lord of All!
- The Basis for Our Unity —All we share together as sons & daughters of the Living God!

The Challenge for Our Day / Application

1. Remember the high calling God has placed upon my life—and seek to live as a follower of Jesus Christ. -"Live a life worthy of the calling you have received..." +Remember who you are...and who you represent!

+ How we live reflects on our Lord & Savior – Act accordingly – Titus 2:10

The Challenge for Our Day / Application

- 2. Purpose in your heart—and practice by your actions—a commitment to the unity of believers around our shared faith in Christ. We're family!
- + Actively seek to safeguard the unity of our church in my actions, words & prayers!
- + Participate in activities that communicate to our world the spiritual unity of the Body of Christ.

The Challenge for Our Day / Application

- 3. Ask God daily for the grace and power to live each day so as to enhance the reputation of Christ—and draw others into the family of God through the Gospel.
