# Tabitha Center - Sponsor a Girl at Kisantu!

God has given us an amazing opportunity to partner with the Tabitha Center we helped start up in Kisantu last year! Many of the young ladies that live near the center struggle to find meaning and have not had the opportunity to attend school, therefore they have difficulty studying the Bible and preparing to learn a trade and many are fatherless.

Global Fingerprints, a sponsorship ministry of the Evangelical Free Church registered Forty-six young ladies for sponsorship! We need at least 25 sponsored before a teacher can be hired. The commitment to sponsor is \$35 a month for 3-4 years. The first year will be learning to read and write. The second year learning a trade and the third year will be interning in the girl's chosen trade. The sponsorship will also provide nutrition, medical care and money toward the Tabitha program. Would you please pray about sponsoring one of these girls? On April 7<sup>th</sup> and April 14<sup>th</sup>, we will have a Global Fingerprints table displaying information on the girls and the opportunity to sign up to sponsor.
