Our focus this month is on Tim & Ginny Craiger serving with SCORE International headquartered in Chattanooga, TN. The Craiger's have been serving the Lord with SCORE International since 1999, where Tim serves as Field Director in the Dominican Republic as well as a recruiter for athletic teams, church groups and senior class trips. Tim also serves on the leadership team at SCORE, which oversee ministry programs, missionaries and development.

SCORE continues to have a major impact by partnering with churches, schools, athletic teams, and others through short-term mission trips. On average, SCORE takes 6,000 people on short-term mission trips each year. 



Parent's Guide To Day Camp

When Is Camp? Camp begins on Tuesday, June 4th, and ends on Friday, June 7th. It runs from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm.

What Ages Are Campers? Camp is for children who have completed Kindergarten through Grade 5. Invite your friends, classmates, neighbors, family members! Everyone is welcome at camp!

How Do I Sign Up My Child For Camp? Simply visit SpringHill's website at springhillcamps.com and scroll down the page to the "Day Camps" section; then simply click on "Find a Location" to find Crossroads! If you don't have access to a computer or the internet, then contact Crossroads to obtain a paper registration form. The church office number is (574) 935-3833.

Where Is Camp Held? Day Camp activities are all hosted at our Plymouth campus so your child will never leave the premises of Crossroads.

Who Runs Camp? SpringHill provides and runs the complete camp experience including fun activities, Bible-based curriculum, and highly-trained camp counselors.

What Is The Cost For Camp? The SpringHill Day Camp pricing structure is:

- \$145 Early Bird (Feb. 14th 28th)
- \$155 Full Price (Mar. 1st May 1st)
- \$175 Late Price (after May 1st)

How Does The Day Camp Prices Compare To Overnight

Comps? There is no comparison between the cost of sending your child to day camp versus an overnight camp for 5 days! The cost to send your child to an overnight camp for 5 days is anywhere between \$300 - \$700. Day camp is a great way to give your child a camp experience close to home for a fraction of the cost!

Are There Scholarships Available? Yes, there are scholarships available if you need help sending your child to camp. Please see the scholarship section on page 6 for additional information.

Before And After Camp Care! SpringHill wants to help parents whose schedule makes it more challenging to get their kids dropped off at the start of camp or picked up at the end of the day. Before and After Camp Care is available if you need to drop your child off early or pick them up late.

Before Care: 8:00 am - 9:00 am; \$35/child*

After Care: 4:00 pm - 5:30 pm; \$25/child*

*If you choose to do both early drop off and late stay, the cost will be \$50 total per child.

How Is Faith And Fun Integrated? SpringHill's goal is to integrate faith and fun throughout each day of camp. Here's how they do that:

- A discussion after every activity that focuses on how they saw God work in that activity
- Every child is given time to hear and understand the message of Christ, and to **go deeper in their faith**
- Large Group Time that is age-appropriate and filled with songs and skits to bring kids' faith alive
- Fun, Christian **role models** who get to know your child in order to help them stretch and grow

What Kind Of Activities Will Kids Do? There's something for everyone at camp! Here are just a few activities your kids will participate in while at camp: archery, bungee trampoline, camp songs, climbing wall, crafts, flying squirrel, paintball targets, slip-n-slide, waterslide, ga-ga ball and more!

Don't forget, the entire group participates in activities together so no one is left out. All activities are supplied and led by SpringHill staff.

Scholarship Information

Need Help Sending Your Child To Camp? We know that attending camp can have a huge impact in a child's life. At camp, kids are pulled out of their normal environment and meet God in new and exciting ways.

Last year at Crossroads during Day Camp 15 campers committed their lives to Jesus while another 12 campers recommitted their lives to Jesus!

If you need assistance sending your child to camp, please pick up a Scholarship Application Packet from our SpringHill Day Camps table located in the Connection Area. You may also contact the church office at (574) 935-3833 or by e-mail at churchoffice@crossroads-efc.org to request a packet.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING...

- If possible, scholarship applicants are asked to contribute some amount to send their child to camp.
- Scholarship applications need to be returned to the church office on or before Sunday, May 12th.

How Will I Know If I Receive A Scholarship? The church office will contact you the week of May 12th (applications are due May 12th) to notify you of your scholarship reward amount. A one-time code will be given to you to register your child on SpringHill's website.

Volunteer At Camp

We Need Your Help At Camp! Even though SpringHill provides the camp counselors, materials and activities for camp, we still need your help to make it all happen!

How Can I Help? There are lots of ways that you can help us during camp! Take a moment and read through all of the various service opportunities below.

Registration Volunteers: 5 people needed

On Tuesday, June 4th, registration volunteers help us process registration quickly and efficiently. They will be stationed at tables and help parents and campers through the check-in process. This is an excellent opportunity to give parents and children a great first impression of Crossroads! Volunteers must be 18 years old. The Day Camp Administrator will train volunteers at 8:00 am on Monday morning.

Time Commitment: Tuesday morning (June 4th) from 8:00 am - 9:30 am **How To Sign Up:** Visit the SpringHill Day Camp Table in the Connection Area

Counselors In Training (CITs): 10 people needed

A CIT's job is to build relationships with campers and assist SpringHill counselors by working with the same group of campers for the entire week. This will include playing GWAPS (Games With A Purpose), singing songs, helping with activities, and talking with kids about what they're learning about God. We love CITs that have a lot of energy, are service-minded, and love Jesus!

Our goal is that through this experience CIT's will also have the opportunity to be mentored by SpringHill staff. CITs are expected to attend a training on Monday, June 3rd, before camp and will be part of the team's morning devotionals. CITs have a significant impact on campers, and this is a relationship that we hope can be fostered even after camp is over! CITs are young people between the ages of 14 - 18 years old.

Time Commitment: Tuesday - Friday; 8:00 am - 4:30 pm (training Monday night - June 3rd)

How To Sign Up: Pick up a CIT Application Packet from the SpringHill Day Camp Table in the Connection Area or speak with Pastor Marc or Pastor Rich.

Volunteer at Camp - continued

Host Homes: 6 - 8 homes needed

A host home houses 2 - 5 SpringHill staff during the week of camp. They will provide dinner on Tuesday and Wednesday and a light breakfast throughout the week. Staff will arrive on Monday evening, June 3rd, before camp and will leave on Friday, June 7th, which is the last day of camp. SpringHill staff have their own transportation during the summer, and host homes will not be asked for rides.

Families who serve as host homes should be flexible, love to host people, and understand that SpringHill staff won't be there all the time. Below are some requirements for host homes:

- Clean House
- Bathroom and shower available
- Bed preferred, however SpringHill does have air mattresses available
- Can accommodate at least 2 SpringHill staff (3 or more preferred)
- Separate rooms (staff should not share rooms with host family members)
- Within 10 miles of Crossroads (strongly preferred)

Time Commitment: Monday Night - Friday Morning **How To Sign Up:** Visit the SpringHill Day Camp Table in the Connection Area

Lunch Prep Crew: 10 - 12 people needed

Lunch prep volunteers will help each day of camp preparing food for SpringHill Staff and Church Volunteers for lunch at 11:30. This role is great if you have a knack for hospitality. You could work all week or just the days you are free. You will be working with a team to help prepare lunch and clean up each day. Food will be provided by church volunteers and dropped off at the church throughout the week. There are no age restrictions for this role.

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 days during the week of camp; possibly from 9:30/10:00 am - 1:30 pm

Provide Food Items For Daily Lunches

Help feed the SpringHill Staff and Volunteers during the week of camp by signing up to provide food items for the daily lunches! It's super easy - Sign up for a food item(s), prepare it (if needed), and drop it off at the church on the day specified. That's it!

Time Commitment: Take a few minutes to purchase the items at the grocery store, prepare it (if needed) and drop it off at the church ready to be used.
