#1 - The Wall of Avoidance - When faced with hard situations, we usually react in one of two ways: facing them head on (fight) or we escape (flight). Conflict avoidance in the hard places of our marriages causes and deepens alienation and isolation.

"Instead of being scared of conflict, couples should see it as an invitation to deeper intimacy." Speak honestly but without accusation about your needs and hurts. Come together in humility with a willingness to listen and truly hear each other. Often marriage conflicts are more a matter of differing perspectives than they are an issue of who is right and who is wrong. "Working through conflict brings two people together in a remarkable way. And learning to face conflict maturely and productively is a part of the process of taking down the wall of avoidance."

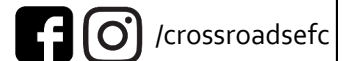

WHAT IS LOVE WEEK?

JULY 6 - 14

WHAT DOES "CONTACT = IMPACT" MEAN? It simply means that we can't expect to have the chance to influence people's lives for Jesus if we're not spending time with them and developing relationships with them! It's only when we invest in people's lives that we can have the opportunity to speak truth into their lives when it really matters!

WHAT ARE WE TRYING TO ACCOMPLISH? We're trying to accomplish several things. *First*, we want to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those that we serve. *Second*, we're exposing our church family to the needs of our community and helping fulfill those needs. We do this through strategic partnerships with various organizations in our community. Our goal is to come along side them to simply ask the question, "What can we do to help you?". *Third*, our desire is that our service during Love Week becomes a lifestyle for our church family...not just a once a year kind of thing but a life of service to others!

[Love Week is when our entire church intentionally looks for opportunities to serve others in our community. We blitz our neighborhoods and communities with acts of service for the entire week.]

HOW CAN I SERVE? There are two ways for you to serve during Love Week. *First*, sign up for a project that's been set up with one of our community organizations. *Second*, discover how you can bless someone at work, in your neighborhood or in your community where you live! This simply begins by looking around you and seeing if there is a need that you could help with! Perhaps it's asking your boss if there's something else that you could do around the office to help out. Maybe your neighbor could use some help. We'll provide you with an **Impact List** to give you some creative ideas of what you can do for others!

WHAT ARE YOU ASKING OF ME? Our desire is that every *family* at Crossroads will sign up to help serve on at least one community project and would identify a need around them (work, neighborhood, community) and find a way to fulfill that need. You're welcome to sign up for more than one project! *Most projects are family friendly and so we encourage you to get everyone in your family involved!

I'D LIKE TO SERVE THROUGH AN ORGANIZED PROJECT...HOW DO I DO THAT? Registration for projects will begin on Sunday, June 16th, and end on Sunday, June 30th. Registration will be located in the Connection Area.

WHAT KIND OF PROJECTS CAN I SIGN UP FOR? We have all kinds of ways that you can get involved during Love Week! We're working on organizing the projects now. We anticipate having over 35 projects for you to select from.

I'D LIKE TO DO SOMETHING ON MY OWN BUT I NEED SOME IDEAS TO GET STARTED. We'll publish the **Impact List** which is full of great ideas of things you can do on your own! Make an impact at work, in your neighborhood and in your community!
