### missions moment

Our Missions focus this month is on Dan and Sheryl Ingle who minister with Studio Ten/Guardian Village Ministries in Nepal.

The Ingle's headlined a recent newsletter this way: "We must never assume, when we seem out of options, that God is out of His". The Ingle's virtually live this out on a daily basis. When the Newari people (the Newari are to Nepal as the American Indians are to America) seem almost impossible to reach with the Gospel, one by one they are accepting the gift of salvation in a region where Christians face severe persecution for their faith. As fellow members of the body of Christ, the Ingles are spurring on this conversion and knowledge of God's kingdom through intensive Bible school, discipleship and evangelistic outreach. And just recently, they opened a new Community Center believing they should be doing what Jesus did — love as He does. The Ingles are appreciative of our support and partnership with them as they stand in the gap and ask for continued prayer as they work toward providing a safe place for broken lives to heal. As multiple ministry outreach opportunities present themselves, they are very aware of God's hand of protective healing and mercy and thank each one for their prayers.

This July 1-7, students from Crossroads' Dive Student Ministry are headed to Kansas City, MO for the EFCA Challenge Conference for their summer missions trip.

Challenge is a special blend of missions trip and conference – it's a catalyst for challenging students to live on mission with Jesus everyday, everywhere and with everyone. Jesus lived boldly. And this year's theme at Challenge is *Bold Moves*.

With large group worship and teaching, breakout learning labs, outreach, and even a unique international experience – there is a diverse range of activities for us to engage and serve.

We have the opportunity to significantly impact the people of Kansas City. Every morning we'll gather for worship and teaching and then we're sent to live it out in real time.

Service and outreach projects will mobilize us to serve with our hands, muscles, and servant hearts. Projects include restoring parks and playgrounds, working with homeless shelters, partnering with other city organizations, prayer outreach, and coming alongside of local churches as an extension into their communities.

We want to mobilize students out toward others both locally and globally as disciples who make disciples. While at Challenge, we seek to join God in what He's already doing in the city and by building disciplemaking



momentum for when we come back home.

For many of our students attending, this will be their first missions experience. The total cost per student is about \$750 each which covers the conference costs, lodging, meals and transportation. Our goal is to raise enough money with the special offering to bring the cost down to between \$200-\$300 per student.
