Faith community nursing

Can you believe it's July??? Summer means fun in the sun, but we need to be aware of the possibility of over-heating.....heat exhaustion can occur in adults and children if we are not careful, and can lead to heat stroke, a medical emergency. The first sign is cramping in the legs, and if that occurs, **cool off and drink fluid** until it goes away. Cramping is a sign that the body is losing salt and electrolytes. Cramping and light sweating gives way to more profuse, heavier sweating, feeling lightheaded and a little nauseous, and if you hit heat stroke, your body stops sweating, and can no longer cool itself.

Some of the signs of heat stroke include: red, hot, dry skin; rapid pulse; throbbing headache; confusion; dizziness.

Let the body cool down naturally in early stages of heat exhaustion, but if you miss the signs and it progresses, put ice packs on the groin, armpits and neck where blood flows close to the surface. Other ways to cool the body include immersing the body in cool water, placing the person in a cool shower, or wrapping the person in a cool, wet blanket.
