connecting at crossroads...

We have several ways this fall for you to get connected with others at Crossroads! Why connect with others? We were called to have relationship with God but also with one another! Did you know there are 59 "one another" statements in the New Testament? That's right, 59. That's just under 60 exhortations in Scripture to actually "do" something towards another person.

We don't want to be a church ministry that just "programs"; rather we want to be intentional about creating environments within our ministry that allow you to do the "one-anothering" that we're called to do!

Here are some ways to connect and do some "one-anothering" with one another...

- Join a Community Group @ GroupLink on September 16th! Learn what it means to experience true, authentic Christian relationships in the context of a small group! Let's move out of the rows we're sitting in and into a circle of relationships with one another.
- Target Group classes are offered on Sunday mornings and typically last anywhere from 6 - 8 weeks. These classes meet in Room 105 / 107 and are limited to 40 people. Although they are a bit larger in size, participating in one of these classes is a great way to connect with others while studying God's Word.
