It is estimated that between 40,000 and 70,000 children residing in Bali, Indonesia are victims of child trafficking and prostitution. It is into this dark part of the world that Crossroads supported missionaries Fred and Abigail Lisko carry God's word.

The Lisko's have just reached their half year marker in Bali; truly a big accomplishment and a great opportunity to reflect on how God is moving in their relationship with both friends and neighbors. As they explore opportunities within the anti-trafficking world, they have been given a greater depth of understanding as to the needs in Bali. They witness doors being opened to them by God as they narrow their ministry focus as well as continue to build relationships that hopefully will allow them to share their faith and the truth of God's word.

This is not an easy task in a country where over 80% of the people adhere to Balinese Hinduism. Please pray for the Lisko's for greater clarity for their time in Bali, for growth in their relationships with friends and neighbors and for the spreading of God's word as they face daunting obstacles to their ministry.
