Hypertension – did you know that 1 in every 3 adults in the U.S. has high blood pressure – and only about half of those people have their blood pressure under control? High blood pressure increases your risk for dangerous health conditions, including heart attack, stroke, kidney disease and chronic heart failure. Educating yourself about high blood pressure (hypertension) and having it checked periodically is very important. **Crossroads Faith Community Nursing will be offering blood pressure checks this summer right here at Crossroads.** Come and see us the second Sunday of every month this summer (June through September) to get your blood pressure checked and learn about ways you can stay healthy. Your first opportunity is next Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>! Stop by and get your blood pressure checked!
