What are Community Groups? Community Groups are small groups of people meeting weekly with others to develop healthy relationships and to grow in their faith. They are safe environments to be yourself, to learn more about God through the study of his Word and to be cared for by a small group of people.

Honestly, we don't want you to simply come to church on a Sunday morning and then, week after week, , slip out after service without ever really connecting with anyone. Yes, you need to come to church every Sunday to worship corporately with others but there's more to it than just that! We're NOT called to live life in isolation where we don't engage with others. Instead, God's Word calls us to do life WITH ONE ANOTHER! When we move out of the "rows" on a Sunday morning and, in to "circles" with a small group of people each week, that's when we can really apply God's Word to our lives, find people who truly care for us, and who will do life with us! We truly believe that Life Is Better Connected!

You don't have to have life figured out to participate in a Community Group. You're not expected to know everything there is to know about being a Christian, God and your Bible. No, just the opposite is true! We want to learn together! We simply want you to do three simple things:

1) Show Up: commit to your group, show up to group when they are meeting.

2) Join In: As you feel comfortable, join in the conversation and engage with others in your group.

3) Be Real: Just be yourself; when you're ready, start to let people get to know who you really are.

We've seen that when people begin to do these three things, they begin to truly experience all that Community Groups have to offer. Participating in a Community Group can be life changing! However, the only way you'll ever know that for yourself is to get off the sidelines and join one. This Christian life is not a spectator sport...it's meant to be lived together! (Ecc. 4:9-12)

So, if you're ready to step out of the row your sitting in right now and move in to a circle with others, then it's time to join a Community Group. You can join a Community Group by attending our GroupLink Event on Saturday, February 25th. What are Community Groups? Community Groups are our small group ministry for adults at Crossroads. It's a place where 8-12 adults meet weekly, in someone's home, to develop healthy relationships and engage in God's Word while working to provide care, support, and accountability with one another. They are for adults of all ages, stages of life and spiritual maturity.

Why Community Groups? We want to be disciples who make disciples. We believe that the most effective way to do this is within the context of small groups.

Where do Community Groups meet and how often do they meet? Groups gather together weekly in homes.

What's the format of a Community Group? A typical group meeting might be structured as follows:

- 30 minutes: Social time (snack food is often available; some groups even share a meal together)
- 1 hour: Bible, book, video or curriculum study
- 30 minutes: Prayer requests and prayer

What would be expected of me if I were to join a Community Group? There are three simple things that will help you get the most out of participating in a Community Group...

<u>Show Up</u> = Make a commitment to get connected to your group.

<u>Join In</u> = Participate in the conversation; begin to connect relationally with the people in the group

<u>Be Real</u> = Open up about who you are...who you really are.

How can I join a Community Group? To join a Community Group you simply need to attend our GroupLink Event on Saturday, February 25th. To learn more about the GroupLink Event, just flip to the other side of the paper!

what is GroupLink?

GroupLink is a two-hour event where you will meet and connect with others in your area of town and stage of life to start a Community Group. Community Groups are small groups of approximately eight to twelve adults that meet weekly in someone's home to develop healthy relationships and engage in God's Word while working to provide care, support, and accountability with one another. They are for adults of all ages, stages of life and spiritual maturity.

GroupLink is the primary way to get connected into a group. At GroupLink, we don't place you in a group — you choose your own.


