Team housing is needed the Friday before the conference begins through the morning of departure.

ARRIVAL FRIDAY

Please be at the church by 7:30 PM to meet the team and pick up your guests. They will have already eaten, "dinner will not be needed."

SET-UP SATURDAY

After breakfast, please plan to bring your guests back to the church between 9:00-10:00 AM. They will be setting up for the conference most of the day. The team will have their own transportation for the rest of their stay. Your guests will plan to return to your home between 3:00-6:00 PM for dinner and whatever else you have planned for the evening. See Schedule of Events (attached) for specific times.

SUNDAYS

Team members need to be at the church property approximately two hours before the first service. Your guests will plan to join you for lunch and whatever you have planned for the afternoon. They will return to the church approximately two hours before the evening service, so a simple meal after the service would be greatly appreciated.

REMAINDER OF THE LIFE ACTION CONFERENCE

Monday through Thursday morning, team members will be driving themselves to the church property. They will have lunch and dinner at the church property Monday through Thursday. They will typically return to your home after the evening service, but they will let you know about any nights they will need to stay late at the church.
